Message from Red Lake Fire Rescue Service

Carbon Monoxide (CO) continues to bew a leading cause of accidental poisoning in Ontario, with approximately 65% of all CO incidents occurring in people's home. We remind you to make sure fuel burning appliances such as furnaces and fireplaces are vented to the outside and the venting for the exhaust is kept clear and unobstructed. This includes removal of snow and ice and other debris around the outlet to the outside. We also remind residents to ensure these appliances are inspected and maintained regularly, ensure CO detectors are installed in your home and that these detectors are tested regularly.
