Vulnerable Sector Emergency Registration Form

The Corporation of The Municipality of Red Lake invites residents who require **special assistance** to participate in providing valuable information to the Municipality in the event of a Community Emergency.

Examples of those that are **most vulnerable in an emergency situation**:

- the elderly;
- disabled;
- special medical requirements;
- live alone and no local support network; and/or
- lack of transportation.

The Clerk's Office maintains a listing of the Vulnerable Sector Emergency Registration Forms. If you completed a Vulnerable Sector Emergency Registration Form in 2022 or 2023, you are not required to complete another one, unless your information requires an update.
