#### Be Bear Wise!

Bears are beginning to come out of hibernation. We would like to remind residents that the Feeding of Wildlife By-Law states that no person shall feed or make available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife. In order to minimize wildlife encounters residents must ensure all attractants such as food products/scraps, garbage, pet food and bird seed is properly stored and all waste is to be placed at the curb in the morning of pickup (not the night before).

The Municipality is responsible for enforcing the Feed of Wildlife By-Law. The MNRF and the Red Lake OPP work collectively with our By-Law Enforcement Officer to ensure the safety of our residents as it relates to wildlife encounters, including bear encounters.

**For emergency situations** - if the bear poses immediate threat to public safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behaviour, call 911.

**For non-emergency encounters** – to report a bear or for information call the Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327. You will be connected to an operator during bear season (April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>). Visit <u>www.ontario.ca/bearwise</u> for more information.

### Vulnerable Sector Emergency Registration Form

The Corporation of The Municipality of Red Lake invites residents who require **special assistance** to participate in providing valuable information to the Municipality in the event of a Community Emergency.

Examples of those that are **most vulnerable in an emergency situation**:

- the elderly;
- disabled;
- special medical requirements;
- live alone and no local support network; and/or
- lack of transportation.

The Clerk's Office maintains a listing of the Vulnerable Sector Emergency Registration Forms. If you completed a Vulnerable Sector Emergency Registration Form in 2022 or 2023, you are not required to complete another one, <u>unless your information requires an update.</u>
