### **Emergency Preparedness**

It is a good idea to take the time to consider any potential emergency risks in our area, make a plan and put together an emergency kit. It is important to have emergency kits ready and available in the event you have to leave your home unexpectedly.

Some things to consider including when preparing an emergency kit:

- Food (non-perishable) and a manual can opener
- Water
- Radio (crank or battery-run)
- Flashlight (crank or battery-run)
- Extra batteries
- First Aid Kit
- Candles and matches/lighter
- Important papers
- Extra keys for car and house
- Cash (smaller bills)
- If applicable, other items such as prescription medication, infant formula, diapers, equipment for people with disabilities, food and water for pets, etc.
- Phone charger

### **Notice of Construction**

**Cochenour Infrastructure Upgrades Project** 

The **Municipality of Red Lake** is planning to proceed with watermain and sanitary sewer, and road construction works where shown in the community of Cochenour, Ontario.

### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The work will include replacement of the watermain and sanitary sewer and replacement of the water and sanitary service lines to the project area homes. The firm of Makkinga Contractors (807-935-2792) will be doing the construction work on behalf of the Municipality. A representative from Hatch Limited (807-623-3449) will also be onsite to complete quality assurance inspections. Preliminary and planning work has already begun. The Contractor will be ramping up their operation beginning the week of May 22, 2023, with the entire project taking approximately five (5) months to complete.



During construction, there will be partial or full laneway/road closures to through traffic, disruptions to driveway access, and loss of on street parking and interruptions to the water service. Area residents impacted by the construction work, will be placed on a temporary water supply system. In the interest of safety, please ensure that you remain vigilant of construction traffic and avoid the area if possible.

#### NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING FOR AN OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D09-23-01 ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT, FILE NUMBER D14-23-02

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has received complete applications for an Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law Amendment.

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: Snib Lake, Highway 618 (PT Mining Claim K1474).

**PROPERTY DESCRIPTION:** The subject property is designated Natural Resources and zoned Recreational Residential. Currently vacant.

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF APPLICATIONS:** Amend the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law. Zoning By-Law Amendment entails changing the zoning from Recreational Residential (R5) to Rural Residential (R4). The Official Plan Amendment entails changing the designation from Natural Resources to Rural Residential. The amendments will permit a year-round residence.

**TAKE NOTICE** that the proposed amendments under the above file numbers will be heard by the Planning Advisory Committee on the date, and at the time and place shown below.

**PUBLIC MEETING:** You are entitled to attend this public meeting in person to express your views about the proposed amendments. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by this proposal who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this meeting. If you wish to make written comments, they may be forwarded to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:



- a) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.
- b) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Appeal of a decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of this proposed Amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning By-Law, may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given.
