Notice of New Community Safety Zones

Be advised that Community Safety Zones will be established along the roads in front of St. John School / Ecole Catholique Des Etoiles-Du-Nord, Golden Learning Centre and Red Lake District High School. As Howey Street is owned and maintained by the Ministry of Transportation, we are working with MTO to also implement a Community Safety Zone along the road in front of Red Lake Madsen Public School.

These zones are intended to enhance safety within the area of local schools. If caught speeding in these zones, speed fines will be doubled. We ask that motorists respect the speed zones in these areas for the safety of pedestrians.

The updated Speed and Street Signs By-Law will be passed at the Regular Meeting of Council scheduled for May 21st, 2024 and come into effect immediately thereafter.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PUBLIC MEETING FOR AN EXTENSION OF A TEMPORARY USE PROVISION, FILE NUMBER D14-24-01

Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, s. 39.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has received a complete application for a Temporary Use Provision described as follows:

LOCATION OF PROPERTY: 71 Sandy Bay Road. Refer to the location sketch below.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION: The subject property is designated Rural Residential in the Official Plan and zoned Rural Residential (R4) in the Zoning By-Law.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE APPLICATIONS: The applicant is requesting to extend the current temporary use provision (which temporarily permits a mobile home in an R4 zone) for an additional fifteen months, ending July 19th, 2025.

OTHER PLANNING APPLICATIONS RELEVANT TO THE SUBJECT LOCATION: No other applications have been received as of the date of this notice.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION about the application is available for public inspection during regular office hours at the address shown below.

TAKE NOTICE that the Temporary Use Provision application under the above file number will be heard by the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake on the date, and at the time and place shown below. The Council of the Municipality of Red Lake will consider a decision regarding the application at their regular meeting following this public meeting or at a special meeting (which shall be advertised as per the Notice By-Law).

PUBLIC MEETING: You are entitled to attend this public meeting in person to express your views about the application. If you are aware of any person interested in or affected by the application who has not received a copy of this notice you are requested to inform that person of this meeting. If you wish to make written comments on the application, they may be forwarded to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake at the address below.

FAILURE TO MAKE ORAL OR WRITTEN SUBMISSION: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake before the by-law is passed:

- the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.
- the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Appeal of a decision of the Municipality in respect of the Temporary Use Provision may be made by any person or public body not later than 20 days after notice of the decision is given.


