Restricted Fire Zone

The Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) has implemented a Restricted Fire Zone for the Northwest Region, which includes Red Lake and surrounding areas.

No outdoor fires are permitted during this Restricted Fire Zone, which includes burning of grass, debris and campfires, even when using an outdoor fire grate, fireplace, burn barrel or fire pit. Fireworks are also not permitted during a fire ban. In addition, the Transfer Station cannot accept combustable material (brush, leaves and clean wood) until the RFZ is lifted.

Special considerations for Seniors and/or those with mobility restrictions on Canada Day

The Red Lake Age-Friendly Advisory Committee is collaborating with the Canada Day Committee to ensure that the celebrations are safe, comfortable, and accessible to older adults and those with accessibility needs.

Starting at 11 a.m., seniors with mobility restrictions will be able to ride in a golf cart (**courtesy of Red Lake Marine**) from the Phillip Thomas Vinet Centennial Park parking lot to the main stage and to other locations in the park, as needed. This service will be ongoing until 3 p.m.

A large tent, reserved for all seniors, will be set up next to the stage to protect them from the elements and allow them to enjoy the opening ceremonies and daytime entertainment in full comfort. Chairs will be supplied, however, guests may prefer to bring their own lawn chairs. Bottled water will be provided at no cost. Everyone is encouraged to bring their own picnics and re-usable containers as food choices will be limited and line-ups may be long.


