DUNCAN WILSON LIVED MOST OF HIS LIFE IN COCHENOUR AND GAVE BACK TO HIS COMMUNITY AS A LONG TIME COUNCILLOR FOR THE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF BALMERTOWN AND THE TOWNSHIP OF GOLDEN. DUNC WAS HEAVILY INVOLVED IN THE AMALGATION THAT CREATED THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE AND CONTINUED TO SERVE AS THE <u>FIRST MAYOR</u> OF THE MUNICIPALITY. DURING HIS TENURE, HE WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN FRUITION OF THIS WATER TREATMENT PLANT. BECAUSE OF HIS EFFORTS SAFE DRINKING WATER WAS MADE AVAILABLE AND LONG TERM BOIL WATER ADVISORIES WERE RESCINDED FOR THE TOWNSITES OF MCKENZIE ISLAND, COCHENOUR, MCMARMAC AND BALMERTOWN.

Request relief from Section 5.2 of the Zoning By-Law to reduce lot area per unit, reduce rear yard setback from 10.5 m to 9.1 m, increase number of units from 2 to 3, reduce parking spaces from 5 to 4 and increase maximum height from 7.5 m to 8.3 m.
