DUNCAN WILSON LIVED MOST OF HIS LIFE IN COCHENOUR AND GAVE BACK TO HIS COMMUNITY AS A LONG TIME COUNCILLOR FOR THE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF BALMERTOWN AND THE TOWNSHIP OF GOLDEN. DUNC WAS HEAVILY INVOLVED IN THE AMALGATION THAT CREATED THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE AND CONTINUED TO SERVE AS THE FIRST MAYOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY. DURING HIS TENURE, HE WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN FRUITION OF THIS WATER TREATMENT PLANT. BECAUSE OF HIS EFFORTS SAFE DRINKING WATER WAS MADE AVAILABLE AND LONG TERM BOIL WATER ADVISORIES WERE RESCINDED FOR THE TOWNSITES OF MCKENZIE ISLAND, COCHENOUR, MCMARMAC AND BALMERTOWN.

**LOCATION OF PROPERTY:** 1 Willans Crescent, Cochenour. Refer to the location sketch.
