Christmas Tree Curbside Collection

Residents can place their Christmas Trees curbside for collection on **Wednesday**, **January 10**th, **2024**. Trees must be cut in half and placed on the curbside the evening before or the day of collection. Trees must be easily accessible and not have been plowed into the snow bank. Trees must NOT be wrapped in a plastic bag. Trees will not be collected unless all the above conditions are met.

Trees can also be dropped off at the Municipal Transfer Station for **FREE** during normal operating hours.

Update from Truth & Reconciliation Committee

The Municipality of Red Lake established a Truth & Reconciliation Committee in June 2021 with a mandate to provide leadership, education and action on Municipal responses to the Truth & Reconciliation Commission of Canada's Calls to Action. The committee's first role was to develop the Municipality's Land Acknowledgement Statement which was completed in 2022 and is now read aloud at all Council and Committee meetings. Other projects the Committee has and continues to work on:

- ensuring the Land Acknowledgement Statement is on display at all municipal facilities
- collaborate with partners in organizing various community education events
- participated in a meaningful round table discussion with the Lieutenant Governor of Ontario
- engaged with Patrick Hunter to design community welcome signs which includes indigenous language
- provide input as it relates to cultural components in the future Norseman Park upgrades
- recommend Council name a new street with Indigenous language
- mandatory reconciliation education for all municipal staff
