ADDENDUM #07-2025-001

This addendum forms part of the Bid Documents and amends the original Request for Proposal issued on Wednesday May 7, 2025.

Q1: Can you please clarify the consultation and engagement activities you request[ed]:

Q1-A: List of First Nation Communities you want us to engage with

A1-A: The Municipality would like to clarify that direct engagement with neighbouring First Nation communities is not required for this project. However, many residents of the Red Lake District are members of nearby First Nations. Proponents should ensure that their public engagement approach is inclusive and accessible, recognizing the diverse backgrounds of residents and aiming to capture a broad range of perspectives through the community consultation process.

Q1-B: Period of in person meetings (ideally before winter time)

A1-B: The RFP doesn't specify a period or seasonal guidance for in-person meetings however, the final report must be delivered by December 1, 2025.

Q1-C: Type of engagement (online survey, in person work shop, online work shop, open house, etc)

A1-C: Acceptable engagement types may include surveys, interviews, and digital platforms, but the specific formats (e.g. Workshops, open houses) are not mandated. Proponents are encouraged to incorporate engagement formats that have demonstrated effectiveness in past projects and are suitable for the local context.

Q2: Would the Municipality be able to provide guidance on budget for this opportunity?

A2: The Municipality will not be disclosing budget amounts related to this project, except where such information has been made publicly available through the Municipality's website or published Council documents.
