# It's BACK! FoodCycler In-Home Waste Diversion Program

Council has approved participation in a second round of this Program!

Residents are invited to participate in this 12-week Pilot Project by using the FoodCycler machine in your home. We will be offering 100 FoodCycler units at a subsidized price to registered residents of the Municipality of Red Lake. Registrations will be received on a first-come, first-served bases. Successfull registered participants will be contacted with purchase and pick up information.

NEW! With this round we are able to offer two options for FoodCycler units at a discounted price:

FC-30 unit – 2.5 L capacity (14.2"H X 11"W x 12.6"D) - \$150 same unit as previous program Maestro unit – 5.0 L capacity (13.8"H x 13.8"W x 10.3"D) - \$300
