No Parking By-Law in effect November 1st

Effective November 1st until April 30th there is no parking on any street between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. within the Municipality of Red Lake (Cochenour Townsite is exempt).

As per the Snow or Ice By-Law, No person shall leave any basketball net or any other items on a Highway, Sidewalk or Boulevard that will interfere or obstruct snow removal operations. Now is a good time to start cleaning properties in preparation for snow removal – this includes ALL Municipally owned roads and laneways. Campers, trailers, snowmachines, boats, basketball nets, etc. on roadways and laneways interfere with snow removal. Thank you for your cooperation in removing these items.

Notice of Intent to Name Municipal Roadways

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake intends to pass a By-Law at its Regular Meeting to be held on **Monday**, **November 17**, **2025**, pursuant to the Municipal Act 2001, S.O., 2001, c. 25, as amended, to assign an official name to municipally owned roadways, **Kanawenim Drive and Opichii Street**, Red Lake.

The roadways to be named have been surveyed and registered, and the purpose of this naming is to formally assign a civic road name to the surveyed municipal roadways, representing the final step in the road naming process. This notice is provided in accordance with the Municipality's Notice By-Law.

Notice of Intent to Permanently Close a Portion of a Lane

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake intends to pass a By-Law at its Regular Meeting to be held on **Monday**, **November 17**, **2025**, pursuant to the Municipal Act 2001, S.O., 2001, c. 25, as amended, to close a portion of a municipal lane located between 37 Lassie Road and 3 Fifth Street, Balmertown.

The portion of lane to be closed has been surveyed and registered, and the purpose of the By-Law is to formally close the surveyed lands as a public highway in accordance with Section 34 of the Municipal Act, 2001. This represents the final step in the lane closure process. This notice is provided in accordance with the Municipality's Notice By-Law.
