Clarification Questions and Responses

Q1: Is sod installation required specifically in September, or can it be completed earlier once site grading is finalized?

A1: Sod installation in September is preferred. If proponents cannot meet this timeline, they may propose alternative timing and availability within their work schedule, along with appropriate measures to support sod establishment. The Municipality will review proposed schedules and methodologies as part of the evaluation.

Q2: Is the contractor responsible for daily watering, or will this be handled by the property owner?

A2: Once site works and reinstatement are completed and accepted, property owners will be responsible for watering. The Contractor will be expected to provide watering and maintenance advice at the time of completion.

Q3: Are weekend hours permitted for this project?

A3: As the work takes place on residential properties, weekend access cannot be guaranteed. Proponents should indicate in their submission whether weekend work is proposed and provide corresponding pricing and schedules for work with and without weekend work. The Municipality will review proposed schedules as part of the evaluation.

Q4: Is hydroseeding an approved alternative for this project?

A4: Sod installation is the preferred and specified method for this project. Proponents may submit a price for hydroseeding as an alternative; however, the Municipality will evaluate submissions based on sod installation. The Municipality reserves the right to consider hydroseeding if no compliant or acceptable submissions are received for sod installation.

All other terms and conditions of the Request for Quotation remain unchanged.
